## Roadmap to a COVID Safe Australia – Steps 2 & 3 for Capital Edge Church – V2

## Step 2A Monday, June 1st 2020

- Connect Groups of 20 or less regularly gathering, keeping with 1:4sqm distancing and hygiene practices. (A room is available at CECC on Tues/Thurs/Fri/Sat)
- Department meetings allowed of 20 or less.
- Alpha course allowed of 20 or less.
- Church services, Kidzway and Youth to be streamed on-line as currently practiced.

# Step 2B

#### Monday, June 29th 2020

- Term 3 of Leading
   Edge to commence of
   up to 50 attendees at
   church, keeping 1:4sqm
   distancing and hygiene
   practices.
- Life Enrich courses to commence allowing 50 or less attendees.
- Department meetings allowed of 50 or less.

### Step 3A Sunday, mid-July 2020

- Sunday services of up to 100 attendees commence keeping 1:4sqm social distancing and hygiene practices.
- 4 services 9.0010.15am; 11.0012.15pm; On-line
  service 4.30pm; 6.007.15pm
- Kidzway and Youth to remain on-line at this stage.

### Step 3B Friday, July 24th, 2020

- Friday youth service of up to 100 attendees commence keeping 1:4sqm social distancing and hygiene practices.
- Sunday Kidzway program to commence for morning services -9.00-10.15am; 11.00-12.15pm.

The outlined steps above, while in keeping with government restrictions and recommendations are subject to change.

In the 3 Stage Framework issued by the ACT and Federal Government, there are a number of stipulations that must be followed for religious services. These, along with our own safe guards are listed below:

- 1. Gatherings must not exceed the numbers stipulated (Fed/ACT)
  - 2. Social distancing of 1:4sqm must be adhered to (ACT)
- 3. Safe hygiene practices must be practiced (inc. disinfecting between services) (Fed/ACT/CECC)
  - 4. Gatherings must record contact details of all in attendance (Fed)
  - 5. No food unless individually sealed. Drinks to be self-served. (CECC)
